I will continue as President, Linda DaBiero will join the board as Vice President, Sheri Mayer will continue as Secretary, and Chris Struwe will continue as Treasurer. We thanked Pat Plamondon for serving as Vice President this past year, in spite of many other commitments. If any member of the chapter is interested in serving on the board beginning in August of 2025, she may attend the board meetings to shadow the board and learn more about what we do. 
